2021 Team Play Local Rules

CANYONS: All canyons are to be played as Red Penalty areas, even if the red stakes have fallen over or are missing.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR: Is defined by white lines. In the absence of white lines, any bare areas in the general area may be considered ground under repair.

AERATION HOLES: In the general area, a ball which comes to rest in or on an aeration hole may be lifted without penalty, cleaned, and dropped, as near as possible to the spot where it lay, but not nearer the hole, which avoids such a situation.

SPRINKLER HEADS: All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference from them may be obtained. In addition, if a ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard, and such an obstruction, on or within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball, intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief as follows: The ball shall be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay, which is a) not nearer the hole, (b) avoids such intervention and (c) is not in a hazard or on the putting green. The ball may be cleaned when so lifted.

HOLE #3: The area of boulders under the trees on the right side of hole #3 is a No Play Zone. If it is known or virtually certain that your ball is in the boulders you must take free relief by dropping the ball in the relief area to the right side of the fairway, under the trees.

HOLE #6: Short of the fairway, the ice plant at the bottom of the hill is a Red Penalty Area. You may take Stroke-and-Distance Relief, or Back-On-The-Line Relief or Lateral Relief.

HOLE #9: If the halfway house between #9 putting green and #10 tee area is on your "line of play", you may take free relief by dropping in a relief area.

HOLE #13: The canyon, short of the cart path, is a Red Penalty Area. You may take Stroke-and-Distance Relief or Back-on-the-line Relief, or Lateral Relief.

HOLE #16: The chain link fence on the right side of the fairway is **Out of Bounds**. Beyond the chain link fence on the right side, below the fairway, is a Red Penalty Zone. You may take Stroke-and-Distance Relief, Back-On-The-Line Relief or Lateral Relief. The Penalty Area on the left side of #16 is a **NO PLAY** Penalty Area. The **NO PLAY** Zone starts at the edge of the mown area. You may **NOT** enter this area. You may take Stroke-and-Distance Relief, Back-On-The-Line Relief or Lateral Relief from the inside edge of the No Play Zone.
